



# Why GLM?

# Several factors are rising important public policy and governance challenges...

- The scale and pace of urbanization poses problems of housing, transport, poverty, health and security among others.
- Megacities as engines of growth, economic development and innovation in a globalized world.

# ...And new conceptions of government and policymaking are thus needed to address them

- New ways of managing the demands form the numerous actors involved in urban governance (local governments, States, firms, interest groups, citizens, NGOs...).
- New conflict management mechanisms.

# The programme will prepare you for careers in the governance of large metropolises, either based in Europe or outside Europe

Advisers, consultants and project managers in areas such as urban governance, public health, urban policy, local development, risk governance, planning and property development, urban regeneration plans, social cohesion, urban communication...

#### ...to work in urban and private organizations such as:

International organizations (e.g. UN), global utility firms (water, transport, waste disposal, energy), NGOs in different sectors (democratic governance, environment, housing), urban planning agencies, and international consultant firms.

# The academic programme

# A rigorous academic training in English from academics and international professionals with a great emphasis on:

- Strong academic content.
- Methods and tools (maps, GIS, statistics, qualitative techniques).
- Issues of comparison.
- Individual skills and team work training to deal with highly critical situations.

### The academic programme

#### 1st Semester

- Fundamental courses on public policy, sociology and politics of large metropolis.
- Statistics and qualitative research techniques.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester

- More in-depth courses on public policy, sociology, economic governance and law, spatial analysis.
- Maps, GIS.
- Two electives on regional studies (African cities, Asian cities, Latin American cities, North American cities).
- A one week study trip
- A semester-long capstone project

## The academic programme

#### **3rd Semester**

- Urban policy specialization in several substantive fields (workshops and courses).
- Workshops organized by professionals.
- Management and policy skills (professionalizing track).
- Research methods (research track).

#### 4th Semester (out)

- Two possibilities, both under the supervision of GLM team
  - 1. **Internship** in an urban organization
  - 2. Research field for research track students

#### The Common Core Curriculum

2 compulsory common core courses on social sciences required for all Sciences Po master students

#### At GLM:

1 to be taken during the first semester

1 to be taken during the second semester

# **The Study Trip**

#### Why?

Meet with the urban policies and projects' actors: Policy-makers, local organizations, community leaders, academics, the stakeholders...

#### Where?

Cairo (2011), Istanbul (2012 and 2013), Casablanca/Tangier (2014)

#### When?

Between the Semester 1 and 2 – mid-January

# The Capstone

A **high quality research** conducted by a group of students on a given urban policy question for a professional organization.

**Meet the specific needs** of the organization by **applying knowledge** and research techniques to a "**real world**" **situation**.

Opportunity to **develop professional skills** such as group work, project management, leadership and a sense of responsibility.

#### The Grand Oral exam

The **Grand oral** is a compulsory oral exam common to all Sciences Po master's students, which counts for 6 ECTS. It is compulsory to get the master degree

As of today, a short paper (note d'entretien) to be presented in 10 minutes in front of a jury of 3 people (GLM staff, faculty and professional)
