FASSTRACK ASIA: *The Summer School* 2013



FASStrack Asia

- 6-week programme (10 June – 19 July)
- Take up to 2 modules only
- Choose from 10 modules:
 - *Asian Studies Departments, Economics, Languages*
- Field trips (10-12 days in a SEA country) and/or local visits
- In-depth exploration of a theme or topic in that country
- Study and live with international students from all over the world (*e.g. Yale, Copenhagen, Oxford, Cambridge, UC Berkeley, Tokyo etc*)
- *Part of IARU GSP (for Southeast Asia in Context)*



FASStrack Asia 2013

- U-Town Residential Experience
- Social Events : Local tours / Gala Dinner / etc
- Min. grade of CAP 2.0 to apply
- Special Term Fees + Field Trip Costs
 - *Approx. \$700/module + up to \$2,000*
 - *Field trip costs will vary based on destination & trip duration*
- Financial assistance available for needy students
- UTown housing subsidies available for NUS students

- 6-week programme (24 Jun – 2 Aug)
- Compulsory 2 modules (1 capstone + 1 elective)
- Choice of 3 elective modules:
 - *Sociology, Political Science & Biological Sciences (FoS)*
- Field trips (Week 4: 10-12 days in a SEA country)
- In-depth exploration of a theme or topic in that country
- Min. CAP of 2.0 to apply
- Tuition subsidy of 50%
- For FASS & FoS students:
 - *\$500 fieldtrip subsidy*
- Financial assistance available for needy students
