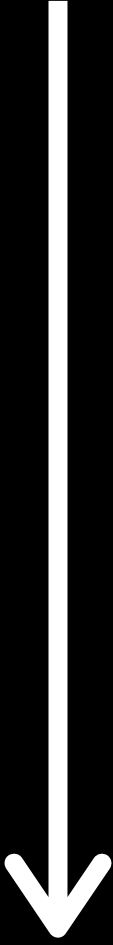


Wild Animals



Domestication

- "the process of hereditary reorganisation of wild animals (and plants) into domestic and cultivated forms according to the interests of people"
- domesticated animals "meet specific requirements or whims (of people) and are adapted to the conditions of continuous care and solicitude people maintain for them"

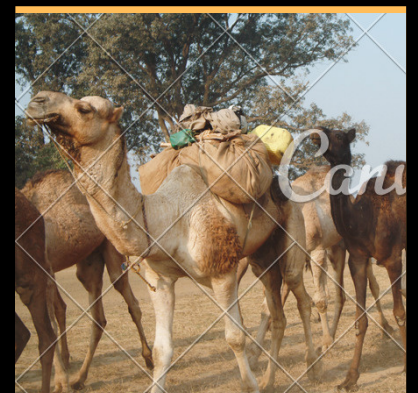
for combat, weapons and transportation
